GARBAGE



Garbage is defined as waste materials from your home and other non-recyclable items. It does not include LARGE SCRAP METAL, APPLIANCES, RECYCLABLES, YARD WASTE, HAZARDOUS WASTE OR CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS. Trash cans and bags must not exceed fifty (50) pounds each in weight. See inside pages for a list of waste materials, collection schedules and proper set-out.

BASURA

BULKY ITEMS



Bulky items are defined as mattresses, furniture, carpeting, etc. It does not include scrap metal, appliances or construction debris. Up to five (5) bulky items can be set out per week on garbage collection days. Carpeting must be cut, rolled and tied in pieces no longer than 5 feet in length.

METALS & APPLIANCES



Metals & appliances are defined as stoves, dishwashers, hot water heaters, refrigerators and other large metal household items. These items are not included in your regular garbage collection. There is a fee for these items. PLEASE CALL THE VILLAGE HALL AT 429-0300 TO ARRANGE FOR PICK-UP. Pick up is every Thursday after the fee has been received. You may pay in person or mail your payment to: 40 New Main Street, Haverstraw, NY 10927.

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS



C & D waste is defined as dirt, tree stumps/trunks, rocks, brick, asphalt, lumber, drywall, roofing material, concrete, etc. These materials will not be picked up by the Village or its garbage hauler. CONTRACTORS MUST CONTACT A PRIVATE WASTE HAULER TO ARRANGE FOR COLLECTION OF THESE MATERIALS.

RESIDENTS WORKING ON THEIR OWN CLEAN-UP OF GARAGES/BASEMENTS



Residents may put out up to two (2) 32 gallon pails of construction debris (as defined above) for pick-up on Thursdays by the Village. Pails must not exceed fifty (50) pounds each. One (1) door may also be included in this pick-up. PHONE VILLAGE TO ARRANGE FOR THURSDAY PICK-UP.

YARD WASTE



Yard waste is defined as leaves, grass, branches and brush. These items are not included in your regular garbage collection. PLEASE CALL THE VILLAGE Hall AT 429-0300 TO ARRANGE FOR A **THURSDAY** PICK-UP. Free lawn and leaf bags available at Village Hall M - F, 9 AM - 5 PM. Grass must be bagged separately from leaves and branches. **YARD WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.**

HAZARDOUS WASTE



Hazardous is defined as paint, pesticides, computers/electronics and other household chemicals. Do not set these items out with your regular garbage or recyclables. They must be disposed of at the Household Hazardous Waste Facility located in Pomona. PLEASE CALL 364-2444 FOR MORE INFORMATION.

RECYCLING



Recyclables must be sorted into two (2) separate recycling bins. (see below)
For new recycling bins call the Village Hall at 429-0300.

- Office, Notebook & Construction Paper (all colors)
- Ledger & Envelopes (all colors)
- Computer, Fax & Photocopy Paper (all colors)
- Newspapers with Inserts
- Junk Mail with Envelopes & Coupons
- Glossy Magazines & Catalogs
- Soft-covered Books & Telephone Books (hard covers can be removed for recycling)
- Smooth & Corrugated Cardboard (cereal boxes, packaging, etc.)
- Brown Grocery Bags

UNACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLES

CONTAINERS Plastic Bags, Styrofoam, Hangers, Toys, Clothing, Appliances, Ceramic, Pots & Pans, Window Glass.

PAPER ITEMS Napkins, Tissues, Paper Towels, Wax Coated Items, Paper Cups & Plates, Hard Covered Books.

There may be some items not listed in this brochure that require special arrangements or fees (such as tires, BBQ grills, microwaves, air conditioners, doors, etc.)

PROPER SET OUT INSTRUCTIONS

All garbage, bulky items and recyclables must be placed curbside (within five (5) feet of a public street or alleyway), by 6:00 AM on the day of collection. If any materials are improperly set out, contaminated, or include unacceptable materials THEY WILL NOT BE COLLECTED. You will receive two warnings in the form of stickers attached to your waste containers stating why it will not be collected in the future if the conditions are not corrected.

INSTRUCCIONES PARA RECOGIMIENTO APROPIADO
