Hi Mike,

The pricing for replacing the firewall at the village is as follows:

1. PC with Arista NG Untangle firewall basic installed and configuration - \$1500
2. Estimated installation time on-site and final configuration - 4 hours - \$560
3. Upgrade to Public Sector security - \$1350, paid annually to Arista via credit card. Signing up for 3 years gets a discount to \$3600 (\$1200/yr)
This upgrade adds to the firewall – Point of Entry Antivirus, Threat and intrusion prevention, web filtering and advanced reporting and several other features we may wish to implement in the future. This covers up to 150 devices on the network, which should be sufficient.

These numbers will be the same for the Community Center, with the exception of line 3, where the CC may qualify as a Nonprofit entity and may be as low as \$650/yr depending on the number of devices that need to be covered. That is a tough number to pin down there because of the computer room, various tablets and TV's that use the internet. After installing the basic firewall and letting it run for a week or so, the firewall will get me a max number of devices it sees over that time and we can go from there. Installation of the upgrade later is no more than an hour to get implemented so waiting a week or two to get a total first is beneficial so we don't over purchase what we need. The public sector version is set at a minimum of 150 devices.
